

New Cranes arrived to the Port of the Americas in Ponce.

We are witnessing the progress being made at the site of the transshipment port of Ponce known as The Port of Las Americas or Puerto Las Américas (PLA) Rafael Cordero Santiago. The space to store cargo is ready and 7 RTG cranes were received in mid September 2008. These cranes will be complimented with other 3 Post Panamax cranes due to arrive at the end of the year. These advanced technologies and logistics will make this a very efficient transshipment port.

The Port of the Americas is a very ambitious project in which we have great expectations for the commercial exchange and economic development of the region. Operations are expected to begin during the first trimester of 2009.
